

PROBE IN FENCE

The Palo Alto Police have asserted that the taser probe that lodged into the fence came from Burger's taser gun.

EVIDENCE:



Agent April Wagner accompanied Palo Alto Fire / Medics to Stanford ER.

At the scene I collected expended Taser XP Cartridge H07-629707. Additionally I collected one related probe from the fence belonging to the residence of 1057 Ramona Street, and the other probe from the side walk along that same fence line. I collected one set of related Taser wires, both still attached to the probes noted above, and several AFIDS all belonging to Taser XP Cartridge H07-629707



A taser probe exits the taser gun traveling at 160ft. Per Second.
Ofc. Burger was standing appx. 6ft. from the residential fence when he fired his taser gun.
That means that the taser probe that lodged in the fence would have entered the fence in .04 seconds or **1/25th of a second**. At 8ft. that would equate to **1/20th of a second**. Burger's taser gun's Data Port and taser video document that he discharged electricity for two seconds.

Officer Burger is heard stating on his MAV recording that he felt the electrical current from his own wires, yet based upon the video footage, Burger did not come in contact with the wires during the 2 second discharge documented in the videos. Additionally, taser wires are insulated to protect them from creating a short circuit. It is possible for the thin insulation to break and or melt away after a long electrical discharge. **(Ciampi has stated that he was shocked by Burger for a minimum of 20 seconds).**

Simply put, had the taser probe that lodged into the fence come from Ofc. Burger's taser gun there would have been no circuit created **and therefore his taser gun would not have discharged electricity for even two seconds.**



CONCLUSION: Since Burger's taser gun Data Port, taser gun activation report and taser video document Burger discharging electricity for **TWO** seconds, the probe in the fence could not have come from Burger's taser gun and **Mr. Hinz's statement that Burger's taser gun's Data Port documented the discharge of electricity accurately is a false statement.**
