As you should be aware, Pursuant to Penal Code section 1054.5(a), the informal discovery procedures outlined in Penal Code Chapter 10 of Title 5 are "the only means by which the defendant may compel the disclosure or production of information from . . . law enforcement agencies which investigated or prepared the case against the defendant . . ." These procedures provide you with the means for obtaining discoverable information. We will not be responding to the unauthorized subpoena.


**Regarding your line-item number 11: Request for booking photo.**
